

OUTCOMES: Empowering Teams for Success

Using the <u>Jefferson Team Observation Guide</u> (JTOG), questions coded to the <u>IPEC Core</u> <u>Competencies</u> are aggregated and averaged. Based on a 7-point Likert scale, 7=Exceptional. Our teams are reporting high functionality and preparation for collaborative success.
