REVIEW THE ETHICAL DILEMMA

Ethical principles to consider: confidentiality, autonomy, relationships with patients, relationships with peers, integrity, professional growth, justice, and social needs

PATH A (CONFIDENTIALITY):

PATH A: YOU PROMISE OMAR TO KEEP HIS SECRET

OUTCOME ONE

OMAR IMPROVES AFTER STARTING THE SUPPLEMENT. YOU MAINTAIN TRUST AND BUILD A STRONG RELATIONSHIP. HOWEVER, YOU CARRY THE BURDEN OF KNOWING POTENTIAL DANGERS REMAIN UNADDRESSED.

OUTCOME TWO

OMAR SUFFERS SERIOUS COMPLICATIONS FROM THE SUPPLEMENT. YOU MUST DECIDE WHETHER TO REVEAL HIS SECRET, POTENTIALLY DAMAGING OMAR'S TRUST OR ALLOWING FOR FURTHER NEGATIVE OUTCOMES BY WAITING.

PATH B: YOU ENCOURAGE OMAR TO CONSIDER SAFER OPTIONS AND TELLING HIS PARENTS

OUTCOME ONE

OMAR IS ADAMANT ABOUT PURSUING THE HERBAL SUPPLEMENT BUT AGREES TO DISCUSS WITH HIS PARENTS. THIS STRENGTHENS YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH OMAR BUT INTRODUCES POSSIBLE PARENTAL PRESSURE.

OUTCOME TWO

OMAR'S PARENTS PRESSURE YOU TO TAKE A STRONGER ACTION AGAINST HIS PLANS. YOU MUST NAVIGATE PARENTAL AUTONOMY VS PATIENT AUTONOMY AS WELL AS A POSSIBLE LEGAL ISSUE.

ETHICAL PRINCIPLES TO CONSIDER: CONFIDENTIALITY, AUTONOMY, RELATIONSHIPS WITH PATIENTS, RELATIONSHIPS WITH PEERS, INTEGRITY, PROFESSIONAL GROWTH, JUSTICE, AND SOCIAL NEEDS

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- 1** **IF OMAR'S CHRONIC CONDITION WERE LIFE-THREATENING, WOULD THAT ALTER YOUR DECISION PATH? WHAT IF IT WERE A COMMUNICABLE DISEASE?**
- 2** **WHAT ETHICAL PRINCIPLES SEEMED TO BE THE MOST CHALLENGING TO UPHOLD IN THIS SITUATION?**
- 3** **HOW CAN UNDERSTANDING DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES (I.E. THE PATIENT'S, PARENTS' OR PROFESSIONAL'S) AFFECT YOUR CHOICES?**
- 4** **WHAT WOULD YOU CONSIDER TO BE BEST PRACTICES IN CONDUCTING THESE CONVERSATIONS WITH YOUR COLLEAGUES?**
- 5** **IS THERE ANOTHER PATH YOU WOULD HAVE LIKED TO TRY?**
