Designed by the Interprofessional Educators & Practitioners Association with contributions from over 80 faculty from across the OUHSC campus and the School of Social Work, this foundational certificate provides virtual learning modules and facilitated group discussion and activities on various topics including the **Interprofessional Education Collaborative (IPEC) core competencies**. The program is offered to all faculty, staff, postdocs, and graduate students at any of the University of Oklahoma (OU) campuses who have interest in leading interprofessional teams.
