



Who We Are






2022-2023 Interprofessional Educators and Practitioners Association (IEPA) Membership & Participation Form


OUHSC Profiles


IPE Logic Model

OUHSC Interprofessional and Interdisciplinary Education – LOGIC MODEL

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
Assessment & Evaluation

To coordinate reporting of IPE-related publications/presentations for inclusion in IEPA reports, including listing on the IEPA website.

Wisdom Family Foundation Interprofessional Education Research Seed Grants -Offered Annually through the Office of Interdisciplinary Programs

GUIDELINES

A project must include three or more professions working as an interprofessional team on a health care related issue or topic addressing one or more interprofessional competencies.
Participation must include diversity both in investigators and student participants.
All applicants must be formally affiliated with the OUHSC or OU at the time of application and implementation of the project.

• Seed grant recipients who successfully complete pilot project components on time as approved by the sponsors, and meet the grant requirements, are eligible to apply for a subsequent seed grant award.

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

12 Week Writing Schedule

The IPE Scholarly Writing Teams follow the Belcher 12-Week Writing Guide.

- 1. Design your plan for writing.
- 2. Advance/organize your argument.
- 3. Write your Abstract.
- 4. Select a Journal.
- 5. Work on your Works Cited.
- 6. Write your Claims for Significance.
- 7. Analyze your Evidence.
- 8. Present your Evidence.
- 9. Work on Article Structure.
- 10. Write your Opening and Conclusion.
- 11. Edit your sentences using the Belcher Editing Diagnostic Test.
- 12. Submit your Article




