Post-Roe Oklahoma - The recent Supreme Court overturn of *Roe v Wade* has impacted abortion provision across the country. In this panel, experts will provide an educational overview of how family planning has changed in Oklahoma.

Perinatal Substance Use - This session will explore how bias and stigma affect patients with substance use disorder in the perinatal period. We will discuss the many implications of perinatal substance use and the variety of treatment modalities available to pregnant and post-partum patients.

Racial Inequity in Reproductive Healthcare - This session will educate attendees on the historical mistreatment of minority groups in medicine and the current impact of racial inequity in reproductive healthcare.

Home Births and Midwives - This session will educate attendees on the roles of midwives and the process of homebirths as well as the reason patients opt for homebirths.

Reproductive Health in Folks with Disabilities - This session will explore the challenges people with disabilities face while seeking reproductive care. We will also discuss things to consider when caring for a patient with disabilities, including both legal and logistical aspects of care.

Rural Reproductive Health - This session features an OB/GYN who will discuss their experience in rural reproductive health and how to manage gynecologic emergencies in rural patients.
